Dr. Kaiser has been an instructor at the Department of State's Foreign Service Institute and served as an election observer for the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) in missions to Azerbaijan, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan. She has lived and worked in Georgia, Ukraine, Russia, and Germany.

Dr. Kaiser earned a PhD in modern Russian history at the University of Pennsylvania; and an MA in Eurasian, Russian, and Eastern European studies and a BS in foreign service from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service. She is term member of the Council of Foreign Relations, and she speaks Russian and Georgian. She lives in Washington, DC with her husband, Mike, and two sons.
