Ambassador Richard Burt, Managing Partner, has led McLarty Associates' work in Europe & Eurasia since 2007. Based in Washington, DC, he also leads McLarty Inbound.

From 1992 to 1995, Richard was a partner with McKinsey & Company, the global management consulting firm. Richard went to McKinsey after successfully concluding a nuclear arms treaty as the U.S. Chief Negotiator in the Strategic Arms Reduction Talks with the former Soviet Union.

Prior to this, Richard was U.S. Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany from 1985 to 1989. Before he served in Germany, he worked at the State Department as Assistant Secretary of State for European and Canadian affairs from 1983 to 1985. From 1981 to 1983, he was the Director of Politico-Military Affairs in the Department of State.

From 1977 to 1980, Richard worked in Washington as the National Security Correspondent for The New York Times. From 1973 to 1977, he worked for the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS) in London, first as a Research Associate and then as Assistant Director.

Richard serves on the board of Deutsche Bank's closed-end fund group and is also a trustee of the UBS family of mutual funds (New York board).
