She has also contributed to edited volumes on nationalism and empire in the Soviet periphery. Claire has been an instructor at the Department of State's Foreign Service Institute and served as an election observer for the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) in missions to Azerbaijan, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan. She has lived and worked in Georgia, Ukraine, Russia, and Germany, including as a State Department Title VIII fellow in Tbilisi.

Claire earned a PhD in modern Russian history at the University of Pennsylvania, and an MA in Eurasian, Russian, and Eastern European studies and a BS in foreign service from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service. She is a term member of the Council of Foreign Relations, and she speaks Russian and Georgian.
