

Vanessa Rubio had a 25 year-long career in Mexico's public sector, including serving as a senator and three times as Deputy Minister (Finance, Foreign Affairs and Social Development). She has vast experience in domestic and international policymaking and implementation, including financial sector regulation; negotiation of international trade, financial, energy and cooperation agreements; and international standards' setting. Vanessa was in charge of Mexico's foreign policy with Latin America and the Caribbean for three years and was a key actor of Mexico's economic and financial relations with the world for almost fifteen years.

She was involved in the first part of the negotiation of the US-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA), finalized the Pacific Alliance treaty, and implemented the Mexico-Central America Single Treaty.

She is Professor in Practice at the School of Public Policy of the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE).
